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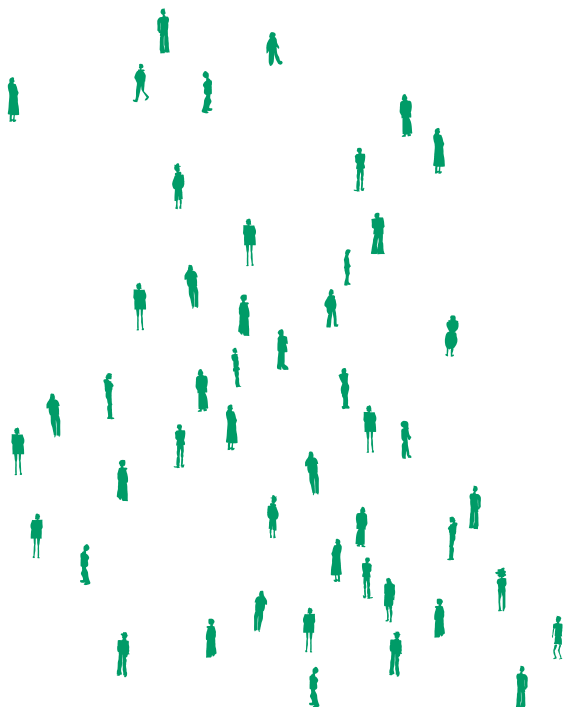


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DRAGI LJUBITELJI GLASBE IN CENJENI PODPORNICI MLADIH GLASBENIKOV,

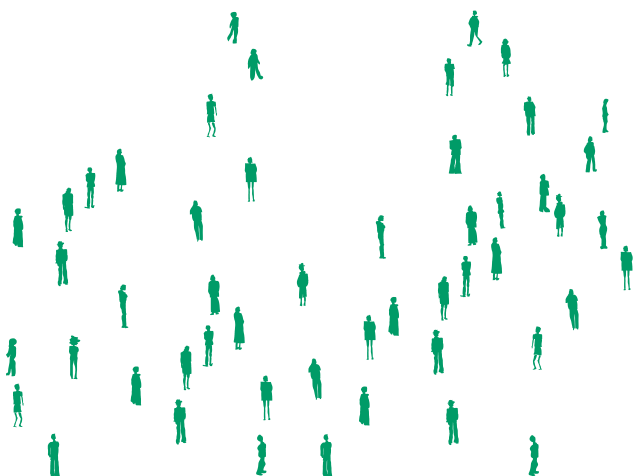

Kai-Min Chang, rojen leta 2001 na Tajvanu, je nedavno osvojil prvo nagrado na prvem Mednarodnem tekmovanju Festivala Ljubljana – Klavir 2023 in prepričal žirijo z uspešno izvedbo *Klavirskega koncerta št. 3 Sergeja Rahmaninova*. Leta 2024 je na otvoritvenem koncertu 7. Zimskega festivala izvedel *Klavirski koncert št.*

2 Johannesesa Brahmsa s Simfoničnim orkestrom RTV Slovenija pod taktirko Yana Pascala Tortellerja. Chang je trenutno

študent pri Dang Thai Sonu na Konservatoriju Nove Anglije. Leta 2021 je bil četrtfinalist na XVIII. Chopinovem tekmovanju v Varšavi. Leta 2018 je osvojil drugo nagrado na Mednarodnem tekmovanju Cooper na Konservatoriju Oberlin ter posebno nagrado žirije na 4. Azijsko-pacifiškem mednarodnem tekmovanju Friderika Chopina. Nastopal je z mnogo orkestri, med drugim s Cleveland Orchestra (Clevelandskim orkestrom), Simfoničnim orkestrom RTV Slovenija in z National Taiwan Symphony Orchestra (Tajvanskim nacionalnim simfoničnim orkestrom).



Hina Khuong-Huu, zmagovalka na Mednarodnem violinskem tekmovanju Elmar Oliveira 2023, je nastopala po vsem svetu kot solistka in sodelovala z mnogo vodilnimi glasbeniki današnjega časa. Eden od osrednjih dogodkov sezone 2023/24 za Hino je bil njen debi v Kennedyjevem centru, kjer je izvedla delo *The Prince of Clouds* Anne Clyne skupaj z dobitnico nagrade grammy Jennifer

Koh, s katero je sodelovala tudi v njeni seriji

Alone Together. V sezoni 2023/24 je Hina prav tako nastopila kot solistka z Boca Raton Symphony Orchestra (Simfoničnim orkestrom iz Boce Ratonca) na Floridi pod vodstvom Alastairja Willisa, kjer je izvedla *Souvenir d'un lieu cher* Petra Iljiča Čajkovskega ter navdušila občinstvo s svojo interpretacijo *Ciganke* Maurica Ravela na koncertu z Northbrook Symphony Orchestra (Simfoničnim orkestrom iz Northbrooka) pod vodstvom Mine Zikrija in Vadima Gluzmana. Hina je nastopila kot solistka z Oxford Philharmonic Orchestra (Filharmoničnim orkestrom iz Oxforda), Chamber Orchestra of Geneva (Komornim orkestrom iz Ženeve), Flanders Symphony Orchestra (Flandrijskim simfoničnim orkestrom), Mitteleuropa Orchestra (Simfoničnim orkestrom Mitteleuropa) in Musica Mundi Orchestra (Orkestrom Musica Mundi). Delila si je oder z Maksimom Vengerovom v Carnegie Hallu ter Buckinghamski palači. Nastopila je tudi v oddaji *NPR From the Top* in prejela karierno štipendijo Salon De Virtuosi. Leta 2018 je zasedla 5. mesto v mlajši kategoriji na Tekmovanju

Menuhin za mlade violiniste. Hina igra na violino Antonia Stradivarija, letnik 1722, »Lord Wandsworth«, ki sta ji jo posodila Fundacija Ryuji Ueno in konzorcij Rare Violins In Consortium, kot znak umetniško-dobrodelnega sodelovanja.

Kai-Min Chang, born in 2001 in Taiwan, won first prize in the 1st Ljubljana Festival International Competition - Piano in 2023, convincing jury members with his performance of Piano Concerto No. 3, by Sergei Rachmaninoff. He most recently returned to Slovenia to perform Piano Concerto No. 2 by Johannes Brahms with the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra at the opening concert of the 7th Winter Festival in 2024. Chang is currently a student of Dang Thai Son at the New England Conservatory. He was a quarterfinalist of the XVIII. Chopin Competition in Warsaw in 2021. In 2018, he won second prize in the Cooper International Competition at Oberlin Conservatory, and the jury's special prize in the 4th Asia-Pacific International Fryderyk Chopin Piano Competition. He has performed with many orchestras, including the Cleveland Orchestra, RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra, and the National Taiwan Symphony Orchestra.

Hina Khuong-Huu, the first-prize winner of the 2023 Elmar Oliveira International Violin Competition, has performed around the globe, appearing as both a soloist and collaborator with many of today's leading musicians. One of the centrepieces of Hina's 2023/24 season was her Kennedy Center debut performing Anna Clyne's *The Prince of Clouds* alongside Grammy Award-winner Jennifer Koh, with who she has also collaborated in her *Alone Together* series. In the same season, Hina was a featured soloist with the *Symphonia in Boca Raton, Florida*, under the direction of Alastair Willis, for Tchaikovsky's *Souvenir d'un lieu cher*, and dazzled audiences with her interpretation of Ravel's *Tzigane* when she appeared with the Northbrook Symphony Orchestra under the leadership of Mina Zikri and Vadim Gluzman. Hina has appeared as a soloist with the Oxford Philharmonic Orchestra, Chamber Orchestra of Geneva, Flanders Symphony Orchestra, Mitteleuropa Orchestra, and the Musica Mundi Orchestra. She shared the stage with Maxim Vengerov at Carnegie Hall and Buckingham Palace. She has performed on NPR's *From the Top* programme, and was a recipient of the *Salon De Virtuosi Career Grant*. In 2018 she placed fifth in the Junior Division of the Menuhin Competition for Young Violinists. Hina performs on a violin made by Antonio Stradivari - c. 1722 »Lord Wandsworth« - which is on loan from the Ryuji Ueno Foundation and Rare Violins In Consortium, Artists and Benefactors Collaborative.

Kuan-Wei Chen je osvojil 1. mesto na 4. Mednarodnem klavirskem tekmovanju Radovljica 2023 in 3. mesto na 4. Mednarodnem klavirskem tekmovanju v Hauts-de-France »Les Etoiles du Piano« v Roubaixu, kjer je prejel tudi nagrado za najboljšo interpretacijo naročenega dela ter nagrado La Flandre Assurances. Februarja 2024 je prejel štipendijo Glasbene fundacije Yamaha v Avstriji.

Igrati je začel pri petih letih, pri 16. pa je bil sprejet na Visoko šolo za glasbo Hanns Eisler v Berlinu, kjer je študiral pri Konradu Marii Englu. Po diplomi je nadaljeval magistrski študij na Univerzi za glasbo in upodabljajočo umetnost na Dunaju pri Ani Malikovi. Osvojil je 1. nagrado na 6. Mednarodnem klavirskem tekmovanju v Troisdorfu v Nemčiji, 3. mesto na tekmovanju za duo flavta-klavir na Glasbenem festivalu Usedom ter izbor za Mednarodni projekt glasbenih talentov 2020/2021, ki ga je organiziral National Taiwan Symphony Orchestra (Tajvanski nacionalni simfonični orkester). Leta 2022 je prejel nagrado New Taipei Music Rising Star. Solistični prvenec je doživel leta 2009 s Taipei Symphony Orchestra (Simfoničnim orkestrom iz Tajpeja) in sodeloval na mojstrskih tečajih pri Arieju Vardiju, Robertu Levinu, Berndu Goetzkeju, Alekseju Lubimovu in Claudiu Martinezu-Mehnerju.



Klavirski trio Ad Astra sestavljajo pianistka Neža Tovšak, violinistka Marija Terezija Kolman in violončelistka Nuša Planinc. Neža je po končani Glasbeni šoli Fran Korun Koželjski Velenje šolanje nadaljevala na Konservatoriju za glasbo in balet Ljubljana. Študira na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani pri Rubenu Dalibaltajanu, kjer je diplomirala z odliko. Prejela je

zlata in srebrna priznanja na tekmovanjih, nastopila v Slovenski filharmoniji in na recitalu *Solo e da camera*. Prihodnjo sezono bo izvedla *Prvi koncert za klavir in orkester* Sergeja Rahmaninova. Je prejemnica štipendije Rotary kluba Ljubljana. Marija Terezija je šolanje začela na Glasbeni šoli Laško-Radeče, nadaljevala na umetniški gimnaziji v Celju ter z odliko diplomirala na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani pri Vasiliju Meljnikovu. Na TEMSIG-u je prejela eno zlato priznanje in tri srebrna. Nagrajena je bila na Mednarodnem tekmovanju mladih glasbenikov Antonio Salieri in Mednarodnem glasbenem tekmovanju North. 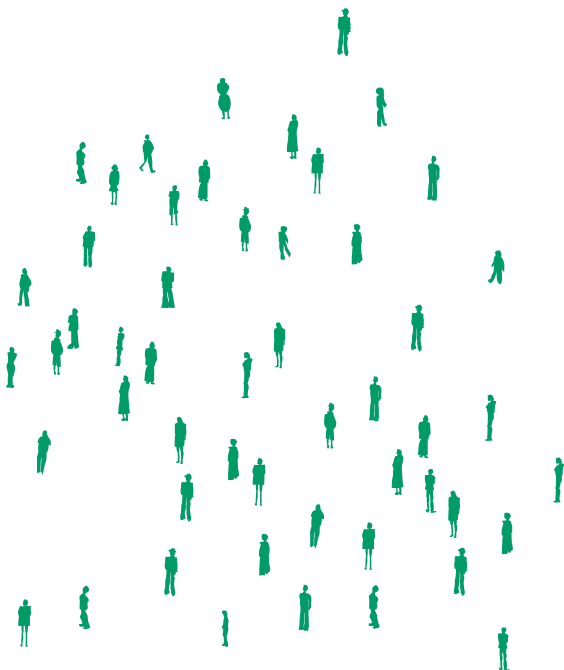

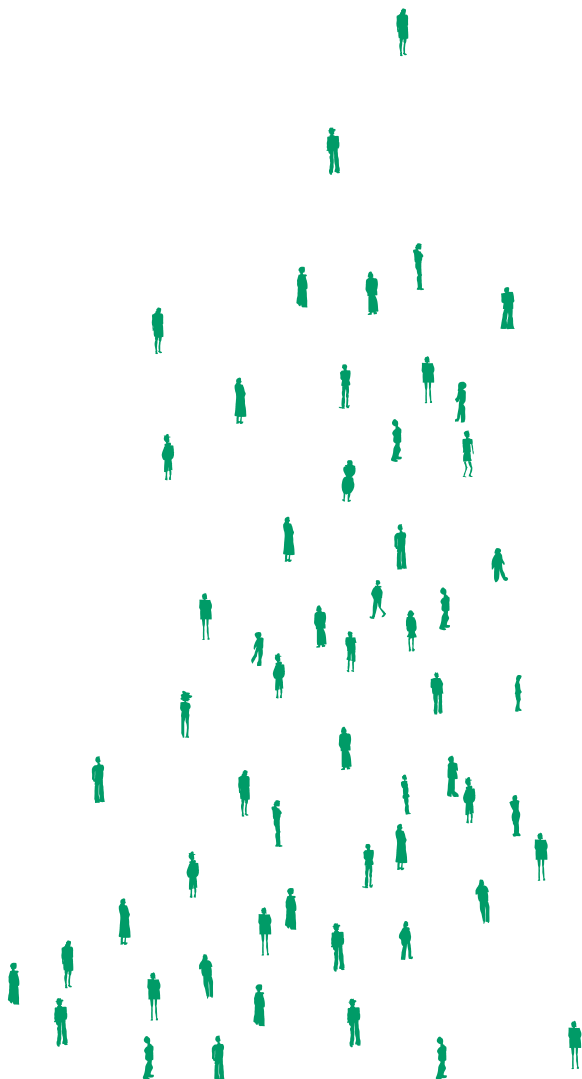

Nadaljevala je študij na Zasebni univerzi za glasbo in umetnost na Dunaju pri Martynu van den Hoeku in se udeležila mojstrskih tečajev pri priznanih pianistih. Prejela je številne nagrade na državnih in mednarodnih tekmovanjih ter nastopila z Orkestrom Slovenske filharmonije in Simfoničnim orkestrom RTV Slovenija. Kot komorna glasbenica igra z uveljavljenimi slovenskimi in tujimi umetniki, sodeluje z zbori, kot so Zbor Slovenske filharmonije in Zbor Francoskega radia. Pogosto korepetira na mojstrskih tečajih. Na Mednarodnem glasbenem tekmovanju Ars nova v Trstu je osvojila prvo nagrado in nagrado za absolutnega zmagovalca v svoji kategoriji. Pomemben dosežek je solistična izvedba *Koncerta za violončelo v e-molu* Edwarda Elgarja s Simfoničnim orkestrom Konservatorija Maribor. Posnel je zgoščenko s skladbami Sergeja Prokofjeva in Roberta Schumanna ter debitiral v Cankarjevem domu v Ljubljani. Bil je prvi študent Glasbene akademije Univerze v Zagrebu, ki je študiral v Hangzhou pri Yang Dingu. Prejel je rektorjevo in dekanovo nagrado ter magistriral leta 2021. Izpopolnjuje se pri Aleksandru Serdarju, je član Klavirskega tria Xylos, s katerim mednarodno nastopa. Od leta 2020 do 2023 je bil profesor klavirja v Glasbeni šoli Ferdo Livadić, zdaj pa je zaposlen na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani in je umetniški vodja festivala Luški pomladni večeri na Hrvaškem.

Manca Kosmač is currently a first-year master's student at the Ljubljana Academy of Music, where she studies viola in the class of Maja Rome. She began her musical training as a violinist with Polona Češarek at the Music School of the Ljubljana Conservatoire of Music and Ballet and continued her studies at the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet with Janez Podlessek. She has won two gold plaques in the chamber group with strings category, two silver plaques in the violin category and, this year, a gold plaque and first prize in the viola category at TEMSIG competitions. She performs regularly in chamber groups and ensembles. She is the violist of the string chamber orchestra Camerata Laibach, with which she has won international prizes. In the 2023–24 season she joined the string orchestra FB Banda. She is a regular substitute with the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra, the Orchestra of the SNG Opera and Ballet Ljubljana, the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra and various chamber ensembles. In 2023 she played in the European Union Youth Orchestra (EUYO), performing concerts in Austria and embarking on a summer and autumn tour of Europe and Mexico. In 2024 she joined the Gustav Mahler Jugendorchester and was invited on a spring and summer tour of Europe. In July 2024 she attended the international summer academy at the Musikinsel Rheinau in Switzerland (SIMA).

After graduating from the Ljubljana Academy of Music, where she studied with Dubravka Tomšič Srebotnjak, pianist **Andreja Kosmač** went on to study with Martyn van den Hoek at the Music and Arts University of the City of Vienna (MUK) and attended masterclasses with pianists such as Leonid Brumberg, Jacob Lateiner and Robert Ward. She has won numerous prizes at national and international competitions and performed with the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra and the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra. As a chamber musician, she performs with acclaimed artists from Slovenia and abroad. She has also performed with choirs such as the Slovenian Philharmonic Choir and the Radio France Choir. She frequently serves as an accompanist at masterclasses. She teaches at the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet, where her pupils have won prestigious awards. She is an associate at the Ljubljana Academy of Music.

Neža Homšak is currently a second-year student at the Ljubljana Academy of Music. She began playing the cello at the age of seven with teacher Petra Neuvirt. She went on to enrol at the arts gymnasium of the Maribor Conservatory of Music and Ballet, where she was taught by Sebastian Bertoncely, while at the same time attending the First Gymnasium (a general upper secondary school) in Maribor. She was awarded a Dr Roman Klasinc Diploma for her achievements as a student. Her teacher at the Ljubljana Academy of Music is Gal Fa-

ganel. She has won several gold and silver plaques at TEMSIG and this year took first place and received a special diploma for the best performance of the compulsory piece. She has also won several gold plaques at the Svirél international competition, a second prize at the International Young Musicians Competition Antonio Salieri and a second prize at the Musica Goritensis International Music Competition. As a member of the Misterioso Piano Trio she has won a gold plaque and third prize at TEMSIG and a diploma for the best performance of a work by a Slovene composer. She won a primo premio assoluto in her category at the Ars nova Trieste International Music Competition. Another important achievement is her performance as the soloist in Elgar's Cello Concerto with the Symphony Orchestra of the Maribor Conservatory. She performs regularly at numerous events both as a soloist and as a member of various chamber ensembles and orchestras, including the Maribor Chamber Orchestra, the Slovene Youth Orchestra and the Young Maribor Soloists.

Croatian pianist **Sven Brajković** has enjoyed success at numerous national and international competitions, including victory at the 3rd Four Notes International Piano Competition in Abu Dhabi and the prize for best Croatian pianist at the Svetislav Stančić International Piano Competition, which led to a performance with the Dubrovački simfonijski orkestar (Dubrovnik Symphony Orchestra). He also came second at the Croatian Competition for Young Musicians Papndopulo. He regularly performs at festivals such as Samobor Music Autumn, Youngmasters Festival, IKIF (New York), Holland Music Sessions, ISA (Austria), the Ljubljana Festival and Klangforum Carinthia. He was the first student from the Zagreb Academy of Music to participate in an exchange programme in Hangzhou, China, where he studied with Yang Ding. As a student he was awarded the Rector's Prize and the Dean's Prize. He completed his master's degree in 2021 and continues to refine his craft under the guidance of pianist Aleksandar Serdar. He is a member of the Xylos Trio, with which he performs internationally. From 2020 to 2023 he taught piano at the Ferdo Livadić Music School. He is currently employed at the Ljubljana Academy of Music and is the artistic director of the Lug Spring Evenings chamber music festival in Croatia.

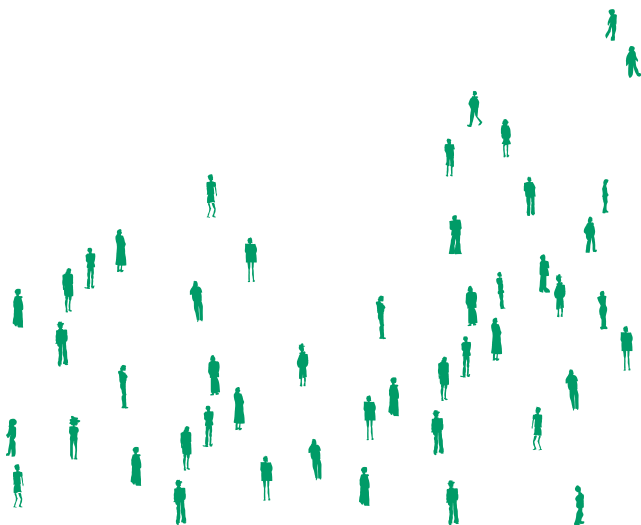

Je prejemnica številnih nagrad na mednarodnih tekmovanjih in festivalih v domovini in tujini, kot so:

Glasbeni festival mladih Črne gore 2019, Mednarodno tekmovanje v solo petju Lav Mirski 2019, Mednarodno tekmovanje v solo petju Nikola Cvejić 2019, Mednarodno tekmovanje v solo petju Lazar Jovanović 2018. V Črni gori je nastopala v projektih, kot so opera *La bohème* (Crnogorsko narodno pozorišče / Črnogorsko narodno gledališče), *Sen kresne noči* (Herceg Novi), *San o Mikrokozmi* (Muzički centar Crne gore / Glasbeni center Črne gore). Kot koncertna izvajalka nastopa na koncertih doma in v tujini. Sodelovala je z Orkestrom Srpskega narodnega pozorišča Novi Sad (Orkestrom Srbskega narodnega gledališča Novi Sad), Umetničkim ansamblom Ministarstva odbrane Stanislav Binički (Umetniškim ansamblom Ministrstva za obrambo Stanislav Binički) iz Beograda in Orkestrom Fakulteta muzičke umetnosti Beograd (Orkestrom Fakultete za glasbeno umetnost v Beogradu). Januarja 2024 je nastopila na uglednem Plesu svetega Save na Dunaju, ki je letos potekal v palači Hofburg. Debitirala je v opereti *Netopir* v produkciji in režiji opernega studia Fakultete za glasbeno umetnost v vlogi Ide, izvedeni na veliki sceni Narodnega pozorišča, pod dirigentsko palico maestra Srboljuba-Srbe Dinića. Kristina Antić se je rodila v Čupriji. Glasbeno izobraževanje je začela pri osmih letih na Šoli za glasbene talente v Čupriji v razredu Nevene Busarac, pri kateri je diplomirala leta 2022. Kot solistka je uspešno nastopila in prejela ovacije občinstva na uglednih festivalih v Srbiji in tujini. Nastopala je v velikih koncertnih dvoranah po vsej Srbiji, Bolgariji, Italiji ... Je dobitnica

številnih prvih in posebnih nagrad na državnih in mednarodnih tekmovanjih. Udeležila se je mojstrskih tečajev uveljavljenih violončelistov in pedagogov, kot so Santiago Cañón-Valencia (Kolumbija), Stefan Popov (Bolgarija, Anglija), Michel Strauss (Francija), Kiril Rodin (Rusija), Dejan Božić (Srbija), László Fenyő (Madžarska), Denis Severin (Švica) ... Prav tako se je kot članica kvarteta izpopolnjevala na tečajih svetovno priznanih kvartetov, kot so Emerson String Quartet (Godalni kvartet Emerson; ZDA), Van der Pals Quartet (Kvartet Van der Pals; Švedska), Aviv String Quartet (Godalni kvartet Aviv; Izrael) ... Kot članica različnih uglednih orkestrrov redno nastopa v Srbiji, leta 2019 pa je na povabilo maestra Igorja Koretija igrala v European Spirit of Youth Orchestra (Orkestru evropskega mladinskega duha) na turneji po italijanskih mestih. Trenutno je študentka tretjega letnika Fakultete za glasbeno umetnost v Beogradu v razredu Dragana Djordjevića.

Pianistka **Jovanka Višekruna Janković** je magistrirala na beograjski Univerzi za umetnost. Istočasno je zaključila še vzporedni podiplomski študij pod vodstvom Lászla Baranyaya na Glasbeni akademiji Franza Liszta v Budimpešti, sodelovala pa je tudi na številnih mojstrskih tečajih in delavnicah znanih pedagogov in pianistov, kot so Amadeus Webersinke, Arbo Valdma, Mira Jevtić in Igor Lazko. 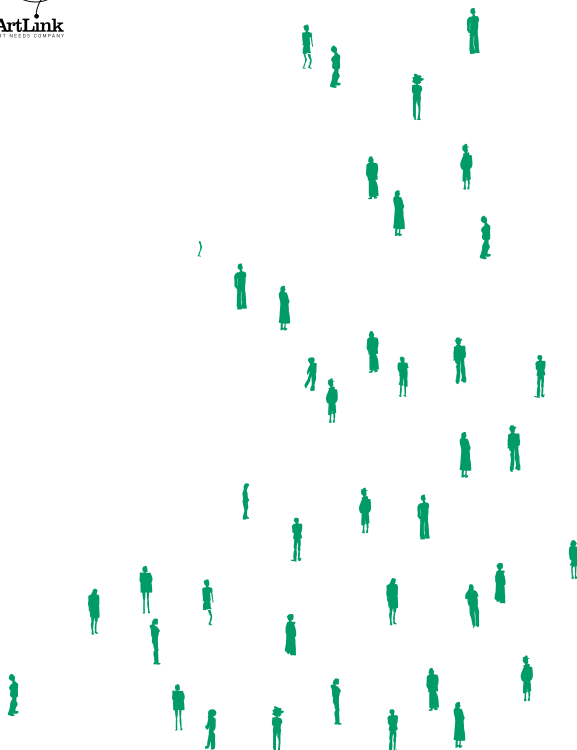
Milica Žižić was born in Podgorica. She received her primary and secondary musical education at the Vasa Pavić Music School. She is currently a fourth-year voice student at the

She has won numerous prizes at international competitions and festivals at home and abroad, including the Festival of Young Artists in Podgorica in 2019, the Lav Mirski International Singing Competition 2019, the Nikola Cvejić International Singing Competition 2019 and the Lazar Jovanović International Opera Competition 2018. In her home country she has appeared in *La bohème* (Crnogorsko narodno pozorište / Montenegro National Theatre), *A Midsummer Night's Dream* (Herceg Novi) and *San o mikrokozmi* (Muzički centar Crne Gore / Montenegro Music Centre). She has worked with the Orkestar Srpskog narodnog pozorišta Novi Sad (Orchestra of the Serbian National Theatre) in Novi Sad, the Umetnički ansambel Ministarstva odbrane Stanislav Binički (Stanislav Binički Ensemble of the Ministry of Defence) in Belgrade and the Orkestar Fakulteta muzičke umetnosti Beograd (Orchestra of the Faculty of Music) in Belgrade. In January 2024 she appeared at the prestigious St Sava's Ball at the Hofburg in Vienna. She appeared as *Ida* in the Belgrade Faculty of Music Opera Studio's production of the operetta *Die Fledermaus*, conducted by Srbojub Srba Dinić, on the main stage of the Narodno pozorište Beograd (National Theatre in Belgrade). She has also appeared as *Stanka* in the opera *Na uranku* (At Dawn) by Stanislav Binički. She has performed at concerts in Belgrade and Tirana as part of the ArtLink Festival.

Kristina Antić was born in Ćuprija. She began her musical training at the age of eight at the School for Musical Talents in Ćuprija, graduating from Nevena Busarac's class in 2022. She has given successful and enthusiastically applauded performances as a soloist at prestigious festivals in Serbia and abroad. She has performed in major concert venues throughout Serbia as well as in Bulgaria, Italy and other countries. She has won numerous first prizes and special prizes at national and international competitions. She has attended masterclasses with renowned cellists and teachers including Santiago Cañón-Valencia (Colombia), Stefan Popov (Bulgaria/UK), Michel Strauss (France), Kirill Rodin (Russia), Dejan Božić (Serbia), László Fenyő (Hungary) and Denis Severin (Switzerland). As a member of a string quartet, she has attended masterclasses with world-famous quartets including the Emerson String Quartet (USA), the Van Der Pals Quartet (Sweden) and the Aviv String Quartet (Israel). She performs regularly in Serbia as a member of various prestigious orchestras and in 2019 performed with the European Spirit of Youth Orchestra (ESYO) on a tour of Italian cities at the invitation of conductor Igor Coretti Kuret. She is currently a third-year student at the Faculty of Music in Belgrade, in the class of Dragan Djordjević.

Jovanka Višekruna Janković, pianist, graduated from the University of Arts in Belgrade with a Master of Arts degree. Simultaneously, she completed her postgraduate studies at the Franz Liszt Music Academy in Budapest in the class of Lázló Baranyay and participated in numerous master classes and workshops of the famous pedagogues and pianists Amadeus Webersinke, Arbo Valdma, Mira Jevtić, Igor Lazko. She performed at numerous recitals and multidisciplinary projects in her home country including the management of the Serbian concert tour, and abroad, including solo recitals in France, Italy, Hungary, Montenegro, Greece, Bulgaria, Macedonia and Canada. After being engaged as an assistant to professor of piano at the Faculty of Music in Belgrade, for a number of years, and as the Vice President of the Young EPTA (European Piano Teachers Association) of Serbia, in 2004, Jovanka Višekruna Janković founded the association of artists ArtLink.

Zala Ažbe je glasbeno pot začela kot učenka klavirja na Glasbeni šoli Škofja Loka. Z enajstimi leti je začela igrati orgle in končala štiri letnike v razredu Klemna Karlina. Glasbeno šolanje je nadaljevala na Konservatoriju za glasbo in balet Ljubljana, kjer se je prvo leto kalila pri Nini Frank. Zadnje tri letnike je zaključila pri Renati Bauer. Zdaj študira na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani pri Renati Bauer, kjer obiskuje 2. letnik. Redno se udeležuje tekmovanj tako na državni kot tudi mednarodni ravni. V letih 2018, 2021 in 2024 je na TEMSIG-u osvojila zlato plaketo. Lani je na 1. Mednarodnem orgelskem tekmovanju IMMCC zasedla 1. mesto v starostni kategoriji in prejela zlato plaketo. Leta 2019 pa je na 1. Mednarodnem orgelskem tekmovanju za mlade organiste Fondazione Friuli v italijanskem Vidmu prejela nagrado za najmlajšega perspektivnega organista. Redno se udeležuje mojstrskih tečajev pri uveljavljenih organistih, kot so Leo van Doeselaar, Nathan Laube, Lorenzo Ghielmi, Wolfgang Kogert, Pavao Mašič.



Nika Frelih je diplomirana organistka Akademije za glasbo v Ljubljani. Z glasbo se srečuje od malih nog – sprva v Glasbenem centru DO RE MI z obiskovanjem ur klavirja, solfeggia, zbora, orkestra, violine in kasneje v Glasbeni šoli Radovljica z orglami in petjem. Glasbeno pot je nadaljevala na Konservatoriju za glasbo in balet Ljubljana z orglami pri Nini Frank in na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani v razredu Renate Bauer. V letu 2022/23 je bila na študijski izmenjavi na Univerzi za glasbo in gledališče v Leipzigu pod mentorstvom Martina Schmedinga in Nicolasa Berndta. Na Univerzi za glasbo in upodabljaljočo umetnost na Dunaju nadaljuje študij orgel v razredu Zite Nauratyill. Navdušujeta jo tudi petje – tako solistično kot tudi zborovsko, glasbena teorija, komponiranje in improviziranje. Prejela je nagrade, tako iz igranja na orgle (zlate plakete in dvakratna prejemnica prve nagrade na TEMSIG-u v letih 2018, 2021, 2024) kot iz solfeggia (zlata plaketa na TEMSIG-u 2015), zmagala je na Slovenski glasbeni olimpijadi leta 2016 in zasedla 4. mesto na Mednarodni olimpijadi. Njena avtorska skladba *Molitev* je bila priporočena v izvedbo na natečaju Glasba zaprtih ust, udeležila se je tudi drugih pevskih, klavirskih in orgelskih tekmovanj. V Glasbenem centru DO RE MI je poučevala glasbene urice, solfeggio in klavir, rada tudi korepetira. Kot organistka je

sodelovala z zbori Glasbene matice Ljubljana in Akademije za glasbo v Ljubljani.

Zala Ažbe began her musical journey with piano lessons at Škofja Loka Music School. She started playing the organ at the age of eleven and spent the next four years studying with Klemen Karlin. She continued her musical training at the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet, initially with Nina Frank and then, for three years, with Renata Bauer. She is currently a second-year student in Renata Bauer's class at the Ljubljana Academy of Music. She is a regular participant in national and international competitions. She won gold plaques at the 2018, 2021 and 2024 editions of the TEMSIG competition. Last year she came first in her age category at the 1st IMMCC International Organ Competition and won a gold plaque. In 2019 she won a prize as the most promising young organist at the 1st Fondazione Friuli International Organist Competition for young organists, held in Udine (Italy). She regularly attends masterclasses with renowned organists such as Leo van Doeselaar, Nathan Laube, Lorenzo Ghielmi, Wolfgang Kogert and Pavao Mašić.

Nika Frelih holds a degree in organ from the Ljubljana Academy of Music. Her first encounters with music came at a young age, initially at the DO RE MI Music Centre, where she had lessons in piano, solfeggio, choir, orchestra and violin, and later at Radovljica Music School, where she studied organ and singing. She continued her musical training with Nina Frank at the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet and with Renata Bauer at the Ljubljana Academy of Music. During the 2022/23 academic year she participated in a student exchange at the University of Music and Theatre in Leipzig, where she was mentored by Martin Schmeding and Nicolas Berndt. She is currently pursuing further organ studies in the class of Zita Nauratyll at the University of Music and Performing Arts in Vienna. Her interests also extend to singing (solo and choral), music theory, composition and improvisation. She has won prizes both for organ (gold plaques and two first prizes at the 2018, 2021 and 2024 editions of the TEMSIG competition) and for solfeggio (gold plaque at TEMSIG 2015). She won the Slovenian Music Olympiad in 2016 and came fourth at the International Music Olympiad. Her original composition Molitev (Prayer) was recommended for performance at the Academy of Music's A bocca chiusa competition in 2022. She has also taken part in other singing, piano and organ competitions. She has taught musical appreciation, solfeggio and piano at the DO RE MI Music Centre and also enjoys serving as an accompanist. As an organist she has worked with the choirs of the Glasbena Matica Ljubljana and the Ljubljana Academy of Music.

Gaja Žnidaršič se je rodila leta 2004 in prihaja iz Cerknice, kjer je obiskovala tudi glasbeno šolo ter se s sedmimi leti začela učiti violine pod mentorstvom Mojce Brank. Glasbeno pot je nadaljevala na Konservatoriju za glasbo in balet Ljubljana, kjer jo je poučeval Žiga Brank. Trenutno obiskuje prvi letnik violine na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani, prav tako pod mentorstvom Žige Branka. Redno se

udeležuje najrazličnejših mednarodnih in tudi državnih tekmovanj, kjer posega po najvišjih nagradah. Na Mednarodnem tekmovanju Mladi glasbeniki mesta Trbiž je dvakrat osvojila 1. mesto. Prav tako je osvojila 1. mesto v letih 2014 in 2015 na mednarodnem tekmovanju Svirél in leta 2017 na Mednarodnem tekmovanju Mladi virtuoz v Zagrebu. Leta 2019 je na tem tekmovanju prejela 3. nagrado. Uspešna je bila tudi TEMSIG-u, kjer je leta 2018 dosegla 2. mesto in 2021 pa 1. mesto. Tam je leta 2023 s komorno skupino Apeiron dosegla 3. mesto. Po najvišjem mestu je posegla tudi na Regijskem tekmovanju mladih glasbenikov Primorske, Mednarodnem tekmovanju Tartini leta 2022 in 2. Mednarodnem tekmovanju Matije Bravničarja 2023. Decembra 2023 je kot solistka nastopila s Simfoničnim orkestrom Cantabile v Cankarjevem domu. V letu 2024 pa je na TEMSIG-u prejela 1. nagrado. Redno sodeluje v različnih orkestrih in se udeležuje seminarjev pri različnih uveljavljenih profesorjih, kot sta Vasilij Meljnikov in Emilio Percan.

Beata Ilona Barcza je madžarska pianistka in komorna glasbenica. Magisterij je opravila na Univerzi v Pécsu na Akademiji za glasbo in vizualno umetnost (2013). Med šolanjem se je udeležila mnogo tekmovanj, na katerih je osvojila številne prve nagrade. Kot pianistka je redno nastopala na recitalih v National Theatre of Pécs (Narodnem gledališču Pécs), skupaj z odlično sopranistko Marianno Váradi. Na Madžarskem se je 3 leta dodatno izobraževala v igranju čembala. Na povabilo Malcolma Bilsona se je v Ithaci (ZDA) udeležila njegovega mojstrskega tečaja fortepiana, v Ljubljani pa mojstrskega tečaja za pedalni klavir Daliborja Miklavčiča.



Kvartet flavt Inuarria je nastal v študijskem letu 2022/23 in deluje pod mentorstvom dr. Karoline Šantl Zupan. Zasedbo sestavljajo študentke Akademije za glasbo v Ljubljani, flautistke Katarina Kas-telec, Lara Oblak, Nuša Dolinšek in Alja Boštjančič. Pogosto igrajo tudi pikolo, altovsko in basovsko flauto. Kvartet aktivno koncertira v sklopu različnih dogodkov, glasbenih ciklov in festivalov ter prireja številne sa-mostojne koncerte po Sloveniji. Septembra 2023 so flautistke nastopile na 27. Mednarodnem festivalu čipke v Lepoglavi na Hrvaškem. Marca 2024 so se udeležile TEMSIG-a, kjer so v kategoriji komornih skupin s pihali zasedle absolutno prvo mesto in prejele zlato plaketo ter posebno priznanje za najboljšo izvedbo skladbe slovenskega skladatelja. Aprila 2024 je kvartet flavt v sodelovanju s skladateljem Simonom Kravosom aktivno sodeloval na mednarodnem študentskem simpoziju, ki je potekal pod okriljem Festivala Ljubljana. Na simpoziju z naslovom *Glasbena interpretacija: med umetniškim in znanstvenim*, so skupaj predstavili rojstvo skladbe *Evocatio* in sodelovanje skladatelja ter izvajalk pri nastajanju skladbe. Flautistke so septembra 2024 v sklopu *Jesenskih serenad*, ki jih organizira Glasbena Mladina Ljubljanska, nastopile na petih koncertih v različnih krajih Slovenije.

Gaja Žnidaršič (born 2004) began learning the violin at the music school in her home town, Cerknica, at the age of seven. Her first teacher was Mojca Brank. She continued her musical journey at the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet, where she was taught by Žiga Brank. She is currently a first-year violin student at the Ljubljana Academy of Music, where she continues to be mentored by Žiga Brank. She regularly participates in national and international competitions, where she competes for the highest honours. She has come first in her category at two editions of the International Competition »Giovani Musicisti« of the City of Treviso and at two editions of the Svirél international competition (in 2014 and 2015). In 2017 she was the winner of the Young Virtuosi International Competition in Zagreb. In 2019 she won a third prize at the same competition. She has also been successful at national TEMSIG competitions, with a second place in 2018 and a first place in 2021. She entered TEMSIG 2023 with the chamber group Apeiron and scored a third place. She has also achieved top placings at the Primorska Regional Young Musicians Competition, the Tartini International Competition (2022) and the 2nd

International Matija Bravničar Violin Competition (2023). In December 2023 she appeared as soloist with the Cantabile Symphony Orchestra at Cankarjev Dom. She won a first prize at TEMSIG 2024. She works regularly with various orchestras and attends seminars with renowned teachers such as Vasilij Meljnikov and Emilio Percan, among others.

Beata Ilona Barcza is a pianist and chamber musician from Hungary. She obtained a master's degree from the Faculty of Music and Visual Arts of the University of Pécs in 2013. As a student, she took part in many competitions and won several first prizes. She gives regular recitals at the National Theatre of Pécs together with the outstanding soprano Marianna Váradi. She is also interested in early keyboard instruments, dedicating an additional three years of study to the harpsichord in Hungary, joining a fortepiano masterclass in Ithaca (USA) at the invitation of Malcolm Bilson and participating in Dalibor Miklavčič's pedal piano masterclass in Ljubljana.

The Invaria Flute Quartet was founded in the 2022/23 academic year under the mentorship of Karolina Šanti Zupan. The quartet is made up of four students from the Ljubljana Academy of Music: the flautists Katarina Kastelec, Lara Oblak, Nuša Dolinšek and Alja Boštjančič. Their flutes are frequently joined on stage by piccolo, alto flute and bass flute. The quartet performs at various events, concert series and festivals and also gives numerous concerts of its own around Slovenia. In September 2023 the flautists performed at the 27th International Lace Festival in Lepoglava. In March 2024 they took part in the national TEMSIG competition, achieving absolute first place in the chamber groups category and receiving a gold plaque and a special diploma for the best performance of a work by a Slovene composer. In April 2024 the flute quartet collaborated with the composer Simon Kravos at an international student symposium organised by the Ljubljana Festival under the title Musical Interpretation: Between the Artistic and the Scientific, presenting the birth of the piece *Evocatio* and the collaboration between composer and performers in its creation. In September 2024 the flautists performed five concerts in various parts of Slovenia as part of the Autumn Serenades organised by Jeunesses Musicales Ljubljana.

Leta 2023 je osvojila prvo nagrado na Mednarodnem tekmovanju flavtistov na Akademiji za uprizoritvene umetnosti v Bratislavi v kategoriji do 21 let, nagrado v kategoriji do 30 let na Mednarodnem flavtističnem tekmovanju Flauta Aurea in posebno nagrado za najboljšo izvedbo skladbe *Sonate v a-molu za solo flavto* Christiana Philippa Emanuela Bacha. Kiara Janko je osvojila že več kot 30 prvih nagrad na mednarodnih in državnih tekmovanjih. Na 52. TEMSIG-u je osvojila 1. nagrado, zlato plaketo in dve posebni nagradi, 1. nagrado, 1. mesto in koncert v cerkvi sv. Andreja in Matije v Colloredu di Monte Albano na Mednarodnem tekmovanju »Talento Contemporaneo« ter 1. nagrado na Mednarodnem tekmovanju Tomaž Holmar v Malborghettu. Igrala je na festivalu Pro et Contra Glasbene akademije Univerze Juraja Dobrile v Pulju ter se predstavila na festivalu *Solo e da camera*. Kot finalistka tekmovanja Virtuosi V4+ 2022 je na Glasbeni akademiji Franza Liszta v Budimpešti zaigrala ob spremljavi Hungarian Radio Symphony Orchestra (Madžarskega radijskega simfoničnega orkestra). Kot solistka je v Poreču in Rovinju igrala ob spremljavi Zagrebačkega komornega orkestra (Zagrebskega komornega orkestra).



Patricija Malovrh Mlačnik se je začela učiti viole pri Roku Hrvatinu na Glasbeni šoli Ljubljana Moste-Polje, nato na Konservatoriju za glasbo in balet v Ljubljani pri Petru Ugrinu, zdaj pa študira na Akademiji za glasbo pri Emilu Cantorju. Udeležuje se tekmovanj, kjer je med drugim osvojila dve zlati plaketi in 1. nagradi na

TEMSIG-u ter naziva lavreata in zlati plaketi spletnega tekmovanja v Beogradu

ter 3. nagrado in lavreat Mednarodnega godalnega tekmovanja Rudolf Baršaj v Rusiji. Je članica komornega godalnega orkestra Camerata Laibach, s katerim so osvojili številne mednarodne nagrade. Z Godalnim kvartetom Ameba so prejeli

1. nagrado na TEMSIG-u in Škerjančevo nagrado. Leta 2022 je v ciklu *Dobimo se na Magistratu* pripravila solo violistični recital, leta 2023 pa je kot solistka nastopila na štirih koncertih v ciklu *GM oder*. Znanje izpopolnjuje na seminarjih pri profesorjih, kot so Wendy Enderle-Champney, William Coleman, Megumi Kasakawa, Emile Cantor, Maja Rome in drugi. Sodeluje z orkestrom AMADEO, Simfoničnim orkestrom Alumni, Simfoničnim orkestrom RTV Slovenija in Orkestrom Slovenske filharmonije, s katerimi koncertira tudi v tujini. Pred kratkim je uspešno opravila avdicijo v SNG Opera in balet Maribor za naslednjo sezono.

Vid Ibic je doslej osvojil 27 priznanj na državnih in mednarodnih tekmovanjih. Med najpomembnejše nagrade šteje prvo mesto na mednarodnem klavirskem tekmovanju Zlatko Grgošević v Zagrebu, zlato priznanje in prvo mesto na TEMSIG-u v letih 2016, 2019 in 2022, je zmagovalec Mednarodnega glasbenega Mladi talenti mesta Gorica leta 2019, laureat in dobitnik pete nagrade na Mednarodnem klavirskem tekmovanju v Kanadi leta 2021 in dobitnik tretje nagrade na Mednarodnem klavirskem tekmovanju Nomea leta 2021. Svoje znanje redno izpopolnjuje na poletnih šolah in klavirskih seminarjih pri priznanih glasbenih umetnikih. Večkrat je snemal v profesionalnih studiih Radia Koper in PianoRooma, nastopal v okviru RTV cikla Mladi virtuozii in graškega festivala Arsonore ter s samostojnim recitalom sodeloval na mariborskih *Poletnih nočeh*. Nastopil je tudi kot solist z orkestrom v Gradcu, z mladinskim mednarodnim orkestrom IPSIA in s Slovensko filharmonijo.

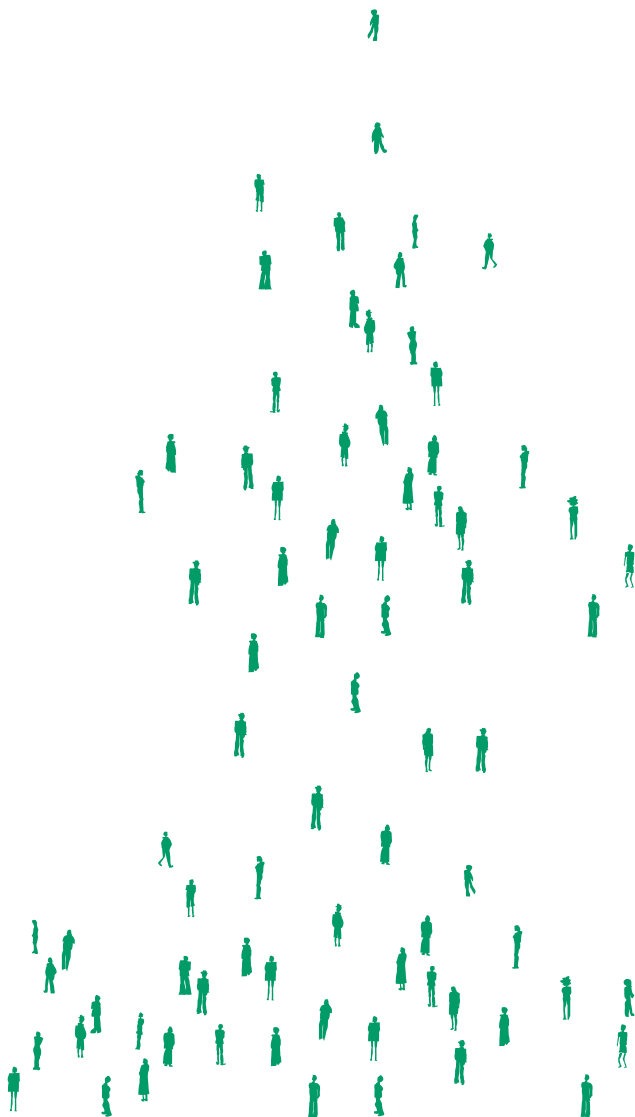
Flauccord Duo, a duo consisting of two students from the Ljubljana Academy of Music, won a gold plaque and first prize with a perfect score of 100 points at this year's TEMSIG competition. Flautist Sofija Mihailović has enchanted numerous audiences with the exceptional musicality of her playing, distinguishing herself both as a soloist and as a member of various orchestras and ensembles. Among her accolades are an outright victory at the International Gathering of Flautists Tahir Kulenović, a gold plaque at the Emona Competition and a third prize at the Anton Eberst Competition for Flute and Clarinet in Novi Sad. In 2023 she won first prize in the under-21 category at the Bratislava International Flute Competition and achieved third place in the under-30 category at the Flauta Aurea Flautist Competition in Croatia, receiving a special commendation for the best performance of Sonata in A minor for Solo Flute by Christian Philipp Emanuel Bach. Accordionist Kiara Janko has won over 30 prizes at national and international competitions, including a first prize, gold plaque and two special awards at the 52nd TEMSIG competition, a primo premio assoluto and a coveted solo concert at the »Talento

Contemporaneo» International Competition in the Church of Saint Andrea and Mattia in Colloredo di Monte Albano, and a first prize at the Tomaž Holmar International Music Competition in Malborghetto. She has performed at the Pro et Contra event organised by the Academy of Music in Pula and appeared at the Solo e da Camera festival. As a finalist in the Virtuosi V4+ competition in 2022, she performed at the Franz Liszt Academy of Music in Budapest accompanied by the Hungarian Radio Symphony Orchestra. She has also appeared as a soloist with the Zagrebački komorni orkestar (Zagreb Chamber Orchestra) in Poreč and Rovinj.

Patricija Malovrh Mlačnik started learning the viola with Rok Hrvatin at Ljubljana Moste-Polje Music School before going on to the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet, where she studied with Peter Ugrin. She is currently studying with Emile Cantor at the Ljubljana Academy of Music. Her competition successes include two gold plaques and two first prizes at the TEMSIG competition, two gold plaques and the title of laureate at an online competition hosted in Belgrade and a third prize and the title of laureate at the Rudolf Barshai International Strings Competition. She is a member of the string chamber orchestra Camerata Laibach, with which she has won numerous international prizes. She has also won a first prize at TEMSIG and a Škerjanc Prize as a member of the Ameba String Quartet. In 2022 she gave a solo viola recital as part of the Meet Me at the Magistrat recital series. In 2023 she appeared as a soloist at four concerts in the GM oder series. She has attended masterclasses and seminars with teachers such as Wendy Enderle-Champney, William Coleman, Megumi Kasakawa, Emile Cantor and Maja Rome, among others. She collaborates with the Amadeo Orchestra, the Alumni Symphony Orchestra, the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra and the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra (with which she has also performed concerts abroad). She recently passed an audition at SNG Opera and Ballet Maribor for the forthcoming season.

Vid Ibic is a 20-year-old pianist from Koper. He began his musical career at the age of six in the class of Valentina Češnjevar. He continued his studies with Selma Chicco Hajdin while also attending a preparatory course at the Graz University of Music and Performing Arts with Zuzana Niederdorfer, where he will complete his undergraduate studies this year. So far, he has won twenty-seven prizes at national and international competitions, including ten absolute first prizes. His major awards include first prize at the Zlatko Grgošević International Piano Competition in Zagreb, golden plaque and first prize at the TEMSIG in 2016, 2019, and 2022, winner of the International Music Competition Young Talents Competition of the City of Gorizia in 2019, winner and fifth prize at the International Piano Competition in Canada in 2021 and winner of third prize at

the Nomea International Piano Competition in 2021. He regularly hones his skills in summer schools and piano seminars with renowned musicians. He has made several recordings in the professional studios of Radio Koper and PianoRoom, performed as part of the RTV Young Virtuosi series and the Arsonore festival in Graz, and participated in the Maribor Summer Nights with a solo concert. He also performed as a soloist with the orchestra in Graz, with the international youth orchestra IPSIA and with the Slovenian Philharmonic.

Nikola Pajanovič je magistriral na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani, v razredu Gorjana Košute. Študij nadaljuje na Kraljevi akademiji za glasbo v Londonu v razredu Romana Simoviča. Uspešno se je udeležil številnih tekmovanj in je nosilec uglednih prvih nagrad na mednarodnih tekmovanjih v Italiji, Makedoniji, Srbiji. Na Violinskem tekmovanju Kocian na Češkem je leta 2016 poleg 1. nagrade v svoji kategoriji pridobil tudi naziv lavreata celotnega tekmovanja. Bil je povabljen na ugledno Tekmovanje Menuhin 2018 v Ženevi in se je uvrstil v polfinale oziroma med 9 najboljših na svetu. Leta 2018 je bil Pajanovič slovenski predstavnik na Evroviziji mladih glasbenikov v Edinburghu in je na finalnem večeru nastopil z BBC Scottish Symphony Orchestra (BBC Škotskim simfoničnim orkestrom) in osvojil 2. nagrado. Do sedaj je šestkrat tekmoval na TEMSIG-u in si vsakič prislužil zlato plaketo. Na zadnjem, marca 2024, je osvojil zlato plaketo, 1. nagrado in posebno priznanje za doseženih 100 pik. V organizaciji Festivala Ljubljana se je dvakrat predstavil v ciklu Mladi virtuoz, prvič februarja 2017 in spet januarja 2018, kjer je izvedel vseh 24 *Capric za violino* Niccolòja Paganinija. Maja 2018 se je predstavili tudi občinstvu v Sarajevu v organizaciji festivala Sarajevski glasbeni večeri. Maja 2019 je bil povabljen v znamenito Teatro del Maggio Musicale Fiorentino (Gledališče Majskega glasbenega festivala v Firencah), kjer se je uspešno predstavil z violinskim recitalom tudi občinstvu v Firencah.

Stefan Pajanovič je začel igrati klavir pri petih letih v razredu Lilijane Žerajič. V letih 2011–2015 se je šolal na Konservatoriju za glasbo in balet Ljubljana v razredu Lidije Malahotky Haas. Leta 2015 je bil sprejet na Akademijo za glasbo Ljubljana, v razred Jasminke Stančul. V letih 2018 in 2019 je študiral v sklopu Erasmusove izmenjave na Visoki šoli za glasbo in gledališče v Münchnu. Septembra 2021 je kot solist nastopil s Simfoničnim orkestrom RTV Slovenija.



Sara Čano se je violončela začela učiti z mamo, Aleksandro Čano Muharemovič. Po končanem Konservatoriju za glasbo in balet Ljubljana je vpisala študij na Visoko šolo za glasbo in gledališče v Münchnu pri Julianu Steckelu, zdaj pa nadaljuje študij pri Milošu Mlejniku na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani. Leta 2017 je v finalu uglednega Mednarodnega mladinskega tekmovanja Čajkovski v Astani igrala *Kon-*

cert za violončelo in orkester Édouarda Laloja s spremljavo Eurasian Symphony Orchestra (Evrazijskega simfoničnega orkestra) in si s tem priborila naziv lavreatke kot prva predstavnica Slovenije v zgodovini tega tekmovanja. S komornim godalnim orkestrom Camerata Laibach pogosto nastopa tako kot vodja violončel in kot solistka. Sodelovala je s številnimi mednarodno priznanimi umetniki, med katerimi so Daniel Rowland, Maja Bogdanović, Anthony Hewitt, Jurij Tkačenko, Vladimir Milošević in drugi. Skupaj z Nikolo Pajanovičem, Lauro de Wolff in Rebeko Skok igra v Godalnem kvartetu Opifex, ki je leta 2023 prejel Prešernovo nagrado Akademije za glasbo v Ljubljani.

Aleksandra Pavlovič je tenkočutna, tehnično podkovana umetnica, ki s predanostjo in umetniško dovršenostjo navdušuje kot solistična interpretka in glasbena pedagoginja. Njena izrazna širina, empatija in izrazit občutek do odrskega partnerja pa jo uvrščajo med iskane in cenjene komorne glasbenice in korepetitorke. Po uspešno opravljeni maturi na Gimnaziji Postojna je leta 1997 vpisala študij klavirja na Državnem konservatoriju P. I. Čajkovski v Moskvi. Študirala je pod mentorstvom znamenitih Leva Naumova in Vladimirja Viarda ter leta 2002 z odliko opravila diplomski nastop. Kot najuspešnejša tuja študentka je nato še istega leta vpisala podiplomski študij pri Andreju Dievu in ga prav tako opravila z odliko. Njen obsežni repertoar poleg pianistične literature obsega tudi večino komornih del, napisanih za violino, violončelo in glas, pri čemer redno sodeluje z uveljavljenimi glasbeniki.

Nikola Pajanović completed a master's degree at the Ljubljana Academy of Music in the class of Gorjan Košuta. He is currently continuing his studies with Roman Simović at the Royal Academy of Music in London. He has participated successfully in numerous competitions and has won prestigious first prizes at international competitions in Italy, North Macedonia and Serbia. In 2016 he won first prize at the Kocian Violin Competition in the Czech Republic and was proclaimed overall competition laureate. In 2018 he was selected to take part in the prestigious Menuhin Competition in Geneva, where he reached the semi-final, as one of the nine best young violinists in the world. In 2018 he represented Slovenia at the Eurovision Young Musicians competition in Edinburgh, performing with the BBC Scottish Symphony Orchestra at the final concert and winning second prize. He has competed in six editions of the TEMSIG competition to date, winning a gold plaque at each. At the most recent edition, held in March 2024, he won a gold plaque, first prize and a special award for achieving a perfect score of 100 points. He has taken part in the Ljubljana Festival's Young Virtuosi cycle on two previous occasions, first in February 2017 and then in January 2018. On the latter occasion he

performed all 24 Caprices for Solo Violin by Niccolò Paganini. In May 2018 he performed at the Sarajevo Music Nights festival in Sarajevo. In May 2019 he was invited to the famous Teatro del Maggio Musicale Fiorentino in Florence, where he gave a successful solo recital.

Stefan Pajanovič began piano lessons at the age of five with teacher Lilijana Žerajič. From 2011 to 2015 he attended the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet, where he was taught by Lidija Malahotky Haas. In 2015 he was admitted to the Ljubljana Academy of Music, entering the class of Jasminka Stančul. In 2018 and 2019 he took part in an Erasmus student exchange at the University of Music and Theatre in Munich. In September 2021 he performed as a soloist with the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra.

Sara Čano began studying the cello with her mother, Aleksandra Čano Muharemovič. After graduating from the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet, she enrolled at the University of Music and Theatre in Munich, where she studied with Julian Steckel. She is currently continuing her studies at the Ljubljana Academy of Music with Miloš Mlejnik. In 2017, at the final of the tenth edition of the prestigious International Tchaikovsky Youth Competition in Astana, she performed Édouard Lalo's Cello Concerto in D minor, accompanied by the Eurasian Symphony Orchestra, and became the first Slovene musician in the history of this competition to be named a laureate. She frequently performs with the Camerata Laibach string chamber orchestra, both as first cello and as a soloist. She has worked with numerous internationally renowned artists such as Daniel Rowland, Maja Bogdanovič, Anthony Hewitt, Yuri Tkachenko and Vladimir Milošević, among others. Together with Nikola Pajanovič, Laura de Wolff and Rebeka Skok, she is a member of the Opifex String Quartet, which in 2023 was awarded the Prešeren Prize of the Ljubljana Academy of Music.

Aleksandra Pavlovič is a sensitive, technically skilled musician who impresses with her dedication and artistic refinement, both as a soloist and as a music teacher. Her breadth of expression, empathy and sensitivity towards her stage partner make her a sought-after and valued chamber musician and accompanist. In 1997, after graduating from the gymnasium in Postojna, she enrolled at the P. I. Tchaikovsky State Conservatory in Moscow, where she studied with the eminent pianists Lev Naumov and Vladimir Viardo, graduating with distinction in 2002. As the most successful foreign student at the conservatory, she immediately enrolled in postgraduate studies with Andrei Diev, again completing them with distinction. In addition to the standard piano literature, her extensive repertoire includes the majority of chamber works for violin, cello and voice and she collaborates regularly with numerous acclaimed musicians.

Nadaljeval je na Konservatoriju za glasbo in balet Ljubljana in sodeloval na številnih državnih in mednarodnih tekmovanjih ter prejel vrsto nagrad, med drugim tudi 1. nagrade na tekmovanjih v Romuniji, Avstriji, Italiji, zlato plaketo in posebne nagrade na TEMSIG-u (2021, 2024), nagrade na tekmovanjih v Sarajevu, Krškem in Črni gori ter 3. nagrado na Great Talent Award na Univerzi za glasbo in upodabljajočo umetnost na Dunaju. Na slednji študira pri Nejcju Kuharju, kjer je na sprejemnih izpitih dosegel najvišje točke med vsemi prijavljenimi. Kot član kitarskega dua Duo Chameleon, s poljskim kitaristom Kamilom Anilom, je prejel 2. nagrado na Kitarskem tekmovanju Altamira v Gorici in Grand Prix na mednarodnem tekmovanju in festivalu Baltski dnevi kitare na Poljskem (2023). 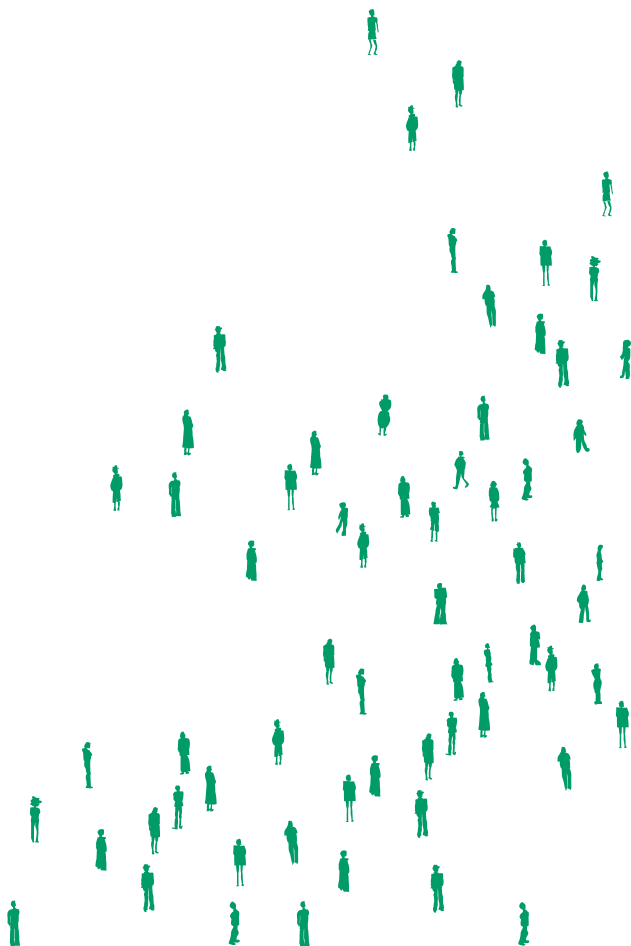

Dosegla je več mednarodnih uspehov, med drugim 2. nagrado na Dnevih kitare Krško (2016, 2017) ter nagrade na Kitarskem tekmovanju Altamira v Gorici, Zagrebški kitarski festival in na Kitarskem forumu na Dunaju. V duu s Tinkaro Majcen je prejela zlato priznanje na TEMSIG-u, leta 2018 pa zlato priznanje in 1. nagrado v kategoriji kitara solo. Prejela je Škerjančevo nagrado in bila izbrana med zmagovalce razpisa Mladi upi. Končala je študij na Višjem glasbenem konservatoriju v Vigu v Španiji pri Margariti Escarpe in izmenjavo pri Lauri Young na salzburški univerzi Mozarteum. Leta 2023 je osvojila 2. mesto na Mednarodnem tekmovanju klasične kitare VelEspana, 1. nagrado na TEMSIG-u (2024) ter posebno nagrado na Kitarskem festivalu v Sinaji. Udeležila se je mednarodnega festivala *Teden kitare* v Postojni, Kitarskega foruma na Dunaju,

Mednarodnega festivala kitarea José Tomas Villa de Petrer, Mednarodnega festivala Guitarra de Guimarães ter mojstrskih tečajev pri svetovno znanih umetnikih, kot so Alvaro Pierri, Marcin Dylla, Brian Head, Judicael Perroy, Zoran Dukić, Aniello Desiderio.

Leon Ravnikar began learning the guitar at the age of seven with teacher Denis Kokalj at Škofja Loka Music School, before going on to study at the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet. He has taken part in numerous national and international competitions and won several prizes, including first prizes at competitions in Romania, Austria and Italy, a gold plaque and special awards at TEMSIG competitions (2021, 2024), prizes at competitions in Sarajevo, Krško and Montenegro and third prize at the Great Talent Award competition organised by the University of Music and Performing Arts in Vienna. He is currently studying with Nejc Kuhar at the latter university, having achieved the highest score of all candidates in the entrance exams. As member of Duo Chameleon (with Polish guitarist Kamil Anioł) he won a second prize at the Altamira Gorizia Guitar Competition and the Grand Prix at the international competition and festival Baltic Guitar Days in Poland (2023). He is also a recipient of the Škerjanc Prize for outstanding artistic achievement. He has performed at prestigious venues in Slovenia and abroad and attended masterclasses with teachers such as Paolo Pegoraro and Augustin Wiedemann, among others. He is considered one of the finest young guitarists performing today, as demonstrated by his numerous prizes and notable successes in competitions.

She continued her musical training with Igor Saje at the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet. She has achieved several international successes including second prizes at Krško Guitar Days (2016, 2017) and prizes at the Altamira Gorizia Guitar Competition, the Zagreb Guitar Festival and Forum Gitarre Wien (in Vienna). She has also won a gold diploma at the TEMSIG competition as half of a duo with Tinkara Majcen and a gold diploma and first prize in the solo guitar category (at the 2018 edition of the competition). She is a recipient of the Škerjanc Prize and was among the successful applicants to the Zavarovalnica Triglav Young Hopes project in 2018. She is a graduate of the Vigo Superior Music Conservatory, where she studied with Margarita Escarpa and

participated in a student exchange at the Mozarteum University in Salzburg, where she was mentored by Laura Young. In 2023 she won a second prize at the VelEspana International Classical Guitar Competition. Since then she has won a first prize at TEMSIG 2024 and a special prize at the 2024 Sinaia Guitar Festival. She has participated in international festivals including Guitar Week in Postojna, Forum Gitarre Wien, the International Guitar Festival José Tomás Villa de Petrer and the International Festival Guitarra de Guimarães and has attended masterclasses with world-renowned artists such as Álvaro Pierri, Marcin Dylla, Brian Head, Judicael Perroy, Zoran Dukić and Aniello Desiderio.

Ana Rodić je trenutno študentka drugega letnika magistrskega študija na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani v razredu Rubena Dalibaltajana. Osnovni študij je končala pri Dubravki Tomšič-Srebotnjak, prva dva letnika je bila v razredu Jasminke Stančul. Že od začetka izobraževanja kaže izjemen talent za glasbo, kar potrjujejo številne nagrade na domačih in mednarodnih tekmovanjih, kot so Mednarodno tekmovanje Mladi virtuoz v Zagrebu, Mednarodno tekmovanje za mlade pianiste v Šabcu, Mednarodno tekmovanje Davorin Jenko, Mednarodno tekmovanje Petar Konjović, Republiško tekmovanje glasbenih in baletnih šol Srbije (lavreat), Mednarodno klavirsko tekmovanje Peter Toperczer v Košicah (2013 – 4. mesto od 5 podeljenih), Mednarodno tekmovanje pianistov Moritz Moszkowski »Per aspera ad astra« (2017 – 2. mesto), Mednarodno tekmovanje Sirmium Music Fest v Sremski Mitrovici (1. nagrada),

Mednarodno klavirsko tekmovanje Janez Matičič (2018 – 2. nagrada). Konec leta 2015 je bila izbrana za Dijakinjo generacije na Osnovni glasbeni šoli Vladimir Djordjević.

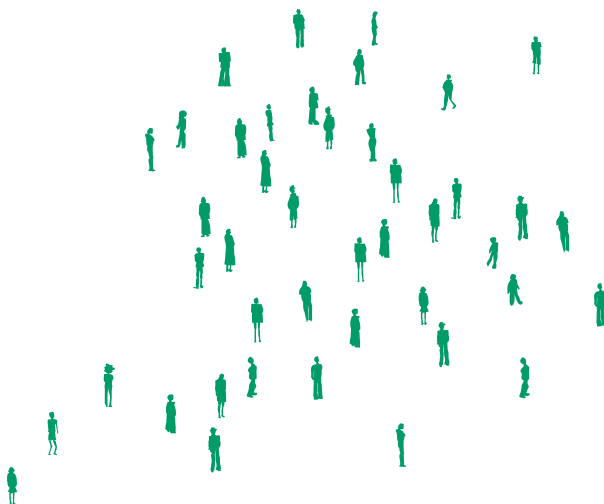
Veronika Vanja completed her secondary musical education at the Ljubljana Conservatory of Music and Ballet, where she studied with Jernej Brence, the founder and artistic director of the Bled Festival. Ana Rodić is currently a second-year master's student in the class of Ruben Dalibaltayan at the Ljubljana Academy of Music. She completed her early training with Dubravka Tomšič-Srebotnjak and spent her first two years at the Academy in the class of Jasminka Stančul. Her exceptional talent was apparent from an early age and is confirmed by the many prizes she has won at national and international competitions including International Competition Young Virtuoso in Zagreb, the International Competition for Young Pianists in Šabac, the Davorin Jenko International Competition, the Petar Konjović International Competition, the Republic Competition of Music and Ballet Schools of Serbia (laureate), the Peter Toperczer International Piano Competition in Košice (2013 – fourth prize of the five awarded), the Moritz Moszkowski International Piano Competition »Per aspera ad astra« (2017 – second place), the International Competition Sirmium Music Fest in Sremska Mitrovica (first prize) and the Janez Matičič International Piano Competition (2018 – second prize). At the end of 2015 she was named the best student of her generation at the Vladimir Djordjević Primary Music School.

Mark Lev Krajnc started his violin studies with Barbara Kolbl, and continued with Danica Koren at the Fran Korun Koželjski Music School in Velenje. He participates in both national and international competitions, and has been awarded first prize at the following: 1st International Young Violinist Competition in Ljubljana (2024), Online International BTHVN Wien Music Competition (2023), Distant Chords Split (2023), London Young Musician (2023), 6th Leon Pfeifer Violin Competition (2022), 4th Laszlo Spezzaferri International Music Prize (2022), 3rd International Tartini Competition in Piran (2022), Young

Musicians International Competition Sonus in Križevci (2022), 12th World Open Music Competition in Belgrade (2021), 50th TEMSIG competition (2021), 1st Matija Bravničar International Competition (2021), the Opus Artis Paris Online Music Competition (2021), and North International Music Competition in Stockholm (2020). He has also taken part in other competitions and achieved impressive results. Among other things, he received the gold prize at the Canadian International Music Competition (2021).

Danijel Brecejl studied piano with Slavush Gadjev at the Conservatory for Music and Ballet Ljubljana, completed his bachelor's and master's degrees at the National Superior Conservatory for Music and Dance in Paris with Roger Muraro and completed a second master's degree at the Mozarteum University in Salzburg in the class of Rolf Plagge. He has attended masterclasses with Jacques Rouvier and Karl-Heinz Kämmerling. He also holds a diploma in harmony from the Paris Conservatory. He has performed with the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra, the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra, the FVG Mitteleuropa Orchestra, and the University of Groningen orchestra, with conductors including Marko Munih and Anton Nanut, among others. He has won first prizes at two editions of the TEMSIG competition and a second prize at the Mayenne International Piano Competition in France. He was a finalist of the International Guido Alberto Fano Piano Competition in Italy and is a laureate of the Yamaha Music Foundation in France. Je prejemnica štipendij Ad Futura Ministrstva za kulturo Republike Slovenije ter prejemnica štipendije sklada Mladi upi. Je varovanka Ustanove Gallus in v zadnjem letu je nastopila z Gewandhausorchester Leipzig (Gewandhaus orkestrom Leipzig) na Salzburškem velikonočnem festivalu, z Mozarteum University's Symphony Orchestra (Simfoničnim orkestrom univerze Mozarteum) pri izvedbi *Prve simfonije* Gustava Mahlerja in opere *Janko in Metka* ter v pomladnem koncertnem ciklusu Bad Reichenhaller Philharmoniker (Bad Reichenhallski filharmoniki). Nastopila je kot solistka z Orkestrom AMADEO, kot vabljenega glasbenica sodeluje z mladimi glasbeniki ob izvajanju novih avtorskih skladb, v različnih komornih zasedbah in pri študijskih snemanjih.



Anej Gorenjak je dijak 3. letnika Konservatorija za glasbo in balet Maribor, kjer študira trobento pri Matjažu Dobrovniku. 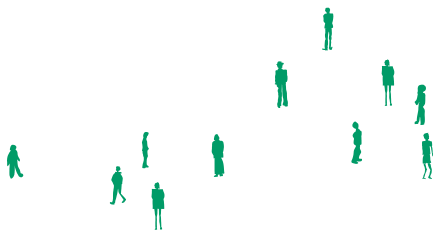

Leto Križanič Žorž is a multiple award winning harpist, with 17 first places at international and national competitions to her credit. She has won several prizes at TEMSIG competitions, from her first appearance in 2012 to her most recent in 2024, where she won an award for achieving a perfect score of 100 points and a commendation for the best performance of a work by a Slovene composer. She graduated with distinction from the State Music Conservatory Jacopo Tomadini in Udine, where she studied with Patrizia Tassini. She is currently completing a master's degree at the Mozarteum University in Salzburg, studying with Stephen Fitzpatrick. She has attended master-classes with world-famous harpists and teachers. She is a recipient of the Dr Roman Klasinc Prize for outstanding achievements at the Maribor Conservatory of Music and Ballet. She holds an Ad Futura scholarship from the Slovenian Ministry of Culture and is supported by the Zavarovalnica Triglav Young Hopes programme. She is a protégée of the Gallus Foundation and over the past year has appeared with the Gewandhausorchester Leipzig (Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra) at the Salzburg Easter Festival, with the Mozarteum University's Symphony Orchestra in a performance of Mahler's First Symphony and Humperdinck's opera Hansel and Gretel, and in the spring concert series of the Bad Reichenhall Philharmoniker (Bad Reichenhall Philharmonic Orchestra). She has performed as a soloist with the AMADEO Orchestra and, as an invited musician, works with young musicians on performances of origi-

nal new works, collaborates with various chamber ensembles and participates in studio recordings.

Anej Gorenjak is a third-year student at the Maribor Conservatory of Music and Ballet, where he studies trumpet with Matjaž Dobrovnik. Before enrolling at the conservatory, he completed seven trumpet classes, six percussion classes and three piano classes at Ravne na Koroškem Music School. He is a member of several ensembles including the Big Band at the Maribor Conservatory of Music and Ballet and has performed and competed internationally. He has studied with renowned trumpeters such as Jure Gradišnik, Roman Rindenberger and Sergei Nakariakov. Among his biggest achievements are numerous international prizes, including a first prize at the 2023 American Protégé International Music Talent Competition, which gave him the opportunity to perform at Carnegie Hall in New York. That same year he gave a solo performance at the St Nicholas's Charity Concert in Cankarjev Dom's Gallus Hall. He regularly attends masterclasses and has enjoyed considerable success at competitions including the TEMSIG competition, the Davorin Jenko International Competition, the Distant Chords Competition in Split and the Amadeus International Music Awards (at which he won a gold prize in 2023).

Špela Horvat began her musical training at the Karol Pahor Music School in Ptuj and continued it with Mitja Vrunč at the Maribor Conservatory of Music and Ballet. In 2019 she completed her master's degree at the Ljubljana Academy of Music, where she studied with Tatjana Ognjanovič. She has performed at many concerts throughout Slovenia and beyond, including a recital at the Slovenian Philharmonic and a guest performance at the Franz Liszt Academy of Music in Budapest. She has also performed with the RTV Slovenia Symphony Orchestra. In 2018 she appeared as the pianist Karmela Kosovel in the documentary film Karmela. In 2019 she performed Alexander Scriabin's Piano Concerto in F-sharp minor at the Slovenian Philharmonic. In 2020 she recorded solo piano works by Claude Debussy for Radio ARS. She has further refined her skills at seminars given by renowned musicians. She currently teaches at the Maribor Conservatory of Music and Ballet, where she also works as an accompanist.

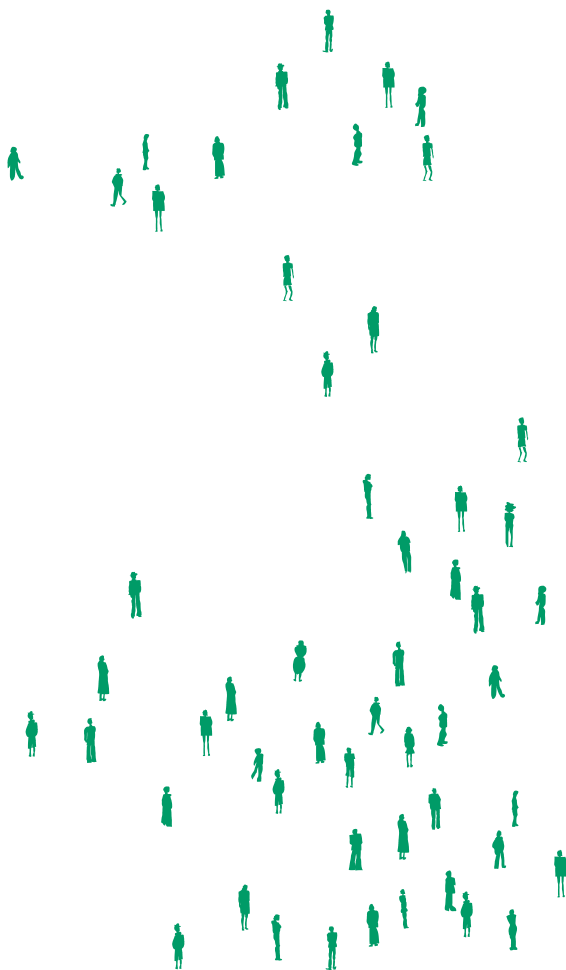
