**RESOLUTION GOVERNING THE  
APPOINTMENT OF A DATA PROTECTION  
OFFICER (DPO)**

1) The following person is appointed personal data protection

officer:

2) In accordance with Article 39 of the GDPR, the Authorised Person will be responsible for:

- (a) informing and advising the controller or the processor and the employees who carry out processing of their obligations pursuant to this Regulation and to other Union or Member State data protection provisions;
- (b) monitoring compliance with this Regulation, with other Union or Member State data protection provisions and with the policies of the controller or processor in relation to the protection of personal data, including the assignment of responsibilities, awareness-raising and training of staff involved in processing operations, and the related audits;
- (c) providing advice where requested as regards the data protection impact assessment and monitoring its performance pursuant to Article 35;
- (d) cooperating with the supervisory authority;
- (e) acting as the contact point for the supervisory authority on issues relating to processing, including the prior consultation referred to in Article 36, and to consult, where appropriate, with regard to any other matter.

3) The DPO is independent in their work. The DPO reports on their work to the organisation's highest management level.

4) The organisation's employees, contract workers and contract processors are obliged to provide the authorised person with the necessary explanations and suggestions for the purposes of carrying out their tasks, and to give the authorised person access to the premises and means for data processing.

5) In carrying out their duties, the authorised person is obliged to protect the secrecy or confidentiality of personal data in accordance with the legislation on the protection of personal data.
