





## ZIMSKI VEČERI VRHUNSKE KLASIČNE GLASBE

Dogajanje v slovenski prestolnici bo konec februarja in na začetku marca zaznamoval že 8. Zimski festival. Premišljeno zasnovan program sestavljajo simfonični in komorni koncerti ter recital v izvedbi umetnikov, ki spadajo v sam vrh svetovne kulture, del festivala pa bo tudi mednarodno tekmovanje.

Prihajajoči festival bomo v sodelovanju s Slovensko filharmonijo in Cankarjevim domom odprli z *Vojnim rekviemom* Benjamina Brittna, ki nosi pomembno in brezčasno protivojno sporočilo. Mojstrovina 20. stoletja bo pod vodstvom maestra Charlesa Dutoita 20. februarja v Cankarjevem domu zadonela v interpretaciji Orkestra in Zbora Slovenske filharmonije, Državnega zbora iz Kaunasa, Dunajskih dečkov in izbranih solistov.

Med 24. februarjem in 1. marcem bo v Slovenski filharmoniji potekalo Mednarodno tekmovanje Festivala Ljubljana, ki bo tokrat namenjeno trobilnim kvintetom in kvartetom. Za glavno nagrado se bo potegovalo 16 zasedb, ki jih sestavljajo mladi glasbeniki iz kar 26 držav. 25. februarja bosta vodilni harfisti Mojco Zlobko Vajgl in Marion Ravot v Viteški dvorani Križank z izvedbo del francoske romantike in impresionizma ustvarili večer, prežet s prefinjenimi melodijami.

Sledil bo nov projekt Marka Hatlaka z naslovom *Bachovi korali in instrumentali*, ki bo raziskoval bogastvo in globino glasbene dediščine Johanna Sebastiana Bacha. Akordeonist je koncert zasnoval v sodelovanju z opernimi pevci Niko Gorič, Bernardo Fink, Domnom Vurnikom in Marcosom Finkom ter glasbeniki Evo-Nino Kozmus, Jeleno Pejić, Stevanom Jovanovićem

in Aleksandro Pavlovič. Na odru se jim bo pod taktirko Jerice Bukovec pridružil še Mešani pevski zbor Glasbene matice Ljubljana.

Dan kasneje bodo v Slovenski filharmoniji gostovali Zagrebški solisti, eden najstarejših hrvaških komornih godalnih orkestrov. Zasedba se bo predstavila z izvedbo del glasbenih velikanov, kot so Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy, Benjamin Britten, Gustav Mahler in Peter Iljič Čajkovski. Festival bo sklenil recital enega najslavnnejših pianistov današnjega časa Grigorija Sokolova. Prepričan sem, da se nam obeta nepozabno glasbeno doživetje, ki ga bosta odlikovala neprimerljiv čut za interpretacijo in tehnična izpopolnjenost.

Vljudno vas vabim, da se nam pridružite in si popestrite zimske večere. Veseli bomo vašega obiska.

## **WINTER EVENINGS OF SUBLIME CLASSICAL MUSIC**

*An undoubtedly highlight of the cultural life of Slovenia's capital city in late February and early March next year will be the Winter Festival, which has now reached its eighth edition. The thoughtfully designed programme includes symphonic and chamber concerts and a very special recital, all performed by top-tier classical musicians of worldwide renown. This year's festival also includes an international competition.*

*In collaboration with the Slovenian Philharmonic and Cankarjev Dom, we will open the upcoming festival with Benjamin Britten's War Requiem, a work with an important and timeless anti-war message. This 20<sup>th</sup> century masterpiece will be performed at Cankarjev Dom on 20 February by the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra and Choir, Kaunas State Choir, Vienna Boys' Choir and eminent soloists, under the baton of conductor Charles Dutoit.*

*From 24 February to 1 March, the Slovenian Philharmonic will host the Ljubljana Festival International Competition, which this time is dedicated to brass quartets and quintets and will*

see 16 ensembles consisting of young musicians from 26 different countries compete for the top prize. On 25 February leading harpists Mojca Zlobko Vajgl and Marion Ravot will fill the Knights' Hall at Križanke with refined melodies as they perform French works from the Romantic and Impressionist periods.

Next on the programme is Marko Hatlak's new project, entitled Bach's Chorales and Instrumentals, which will explore the rich profundity of the musical heritage of Johann Sebastian Bach. The acclaimed accordionist has conceived the concert in collaboration with opera singers Nika Gorič, Bernarda Fink, Domen Vurnik and Marcos Fink and musicians Eva-Nina Kozmus, Jelena Pejić, Stevan Jovanović and Aleksandra Pavlović. They will be joined on stage by the Mixed Choir of the Glasbena Matica Ljubljana, directed by Jerica Bukovec.

The following day, the Slovenian Philharmonic will host the Zagreb Soloists, one of Croatia's oldest string chamber orchestras. The acclaimed ensemble will perform works by musical masters including Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy, Benjamin Britten, Gustav Mahler and Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky. The festival will end with a recital by one of the greatest living classical pianists, Grigory Sokolov. This promises to be an unforgettable musical experience characterised by the pianist's incomparable interpretative sensibility and absolute technical mastery.

You are warmly invited to join us at these events and let music brighten up your winter's evenings. We look forward to welcoming you.





**Benjamin Britten:** Vojni rekviem, op. 66 / War Requiem, Op. 66

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Otvoritev 8. Zimskega festivala bo zaznamovalo monumentalno delo za zbor, soliste in orkester *Vojni rekviem* angleškega skladatelja Benjamina Brittna. Skladba velja za eno izmed najbolj prepričljivih in čustveno nabitih glasbenih stvaritev 20. stoletja. Nastala je za otvoritveno slovesnost nove katedrale v Coventryju, ki je nadomestila zgradbo iz 14. stoletja, porušeno med bombardiranjem v drugi svetovni vojni. Britten je v *Vojnem rekviemu* prepletel besedilo latinske maše za umrle s posvetno liriko angleškega poveljnika Wilfreda Owna, ki je v verzih slikovito upodobil grozote vojne fronte. Vse to je skladatelj združil z značilnim, impozantnim glasbenim izrazom. Kot zaprisežen pacifist je Britten s tem delom ustvaril pomembno protivojno sporočilo, ki je še danes aktualno v svetu, ki ga ponovno pretresajo vojne vihre.

*Vojni rekviem* bo zazvenel v izvedbi **Orkestra Slovenske filharmonije**, rezidenčnega orkestra Festivala Ljubljana 2025, pod taktirko legendarnega maestra **Charlesa Dutoita**, ki se pogosto vrača v slovensko prestolnico. Zasedbo solistov sestavljajo **Nadežda Pavlova**, večkrat nagrajena in kritičko hvaljena sopranistka brezhibnih izvedb italijanskega belcanta, tenorist **Ian Bostridge**, ki posebno pozornost namenja ravno Brittnemu opusu, ter **Matthias Goerne**, priznani baritonist, znan po uspehih tako na opernih odrih kot v snemalnih studiilih. **Zboru Slovenske filharmonije** se bosta pridružila še litovski **Državni zbor iz Kaunasa**, ki mu zaradi kakovosti in natančne priprave nastopov skladatelji pogosto zaupajo prve izvedbe novih del, ter znameniti **Zbor dunajskih dečkov**, ki deluje vsaj od 13. stoletja.

*The 8<sup>th</sup> Winter Festival will open with the monumental War Requiem by the English composer Benjamin Britten. Scored for choirs, soloists and orchestra, it is considered one of the most convincing and emotionally charged works of the twentieth century. It was written for the consecration of the new Coventry Cathedral, built to replace its fourteenth-century predecessor, which was destroyed by bombing in the Second World War. The War Requiem juxtaposes the text of the Latin Requiem Mass with extra-liturgical poems by the English war poet Wilfred Owen, offering a vivid portrayal of the horrors of the front in the First World War. Britten combined these elements*

together into an expressive and powerful work. A committed pacifist, Britten created an important anti-war message with this work, one that still resonates today in a world that is once again torn by wars.

The War Requiem will be performed by the **Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra**, the resident orchestra of the 2025 Ljubljana Festival, conducted by the legendary maestro **Charles Dutoit**, a frequent visitor to the Slovenian capital. The soloists will be **Nadezhda Pavlova**, a multiple award winning soprano who has won critical plaudits for her flawless bel canto, tenor **Ian Bostridge**, an acknowledged Britten specialist, and acclaimed baritone **Matthias Goerne**, known both for his performances on the opera stage and for his studio recordings. **The Slovenian Philharmonic Choir** will be joined by the **Kaunas State Choir** from Lithuania, distinguished by its artistic quality and rigorous approach and frequently entrusted with premiere performances of new works, and the famous **Vienna Boys' Choir**, founded in the thirteenth century.

8. Zimski festival bo tudi letos pospremilo **Mednarodno tekmovanje Festivala Ljubljana**, na katerem se preizkušajo mladi glasbeniki in glasbene zasedbe z vsega sveta. Po lanskem izjemno uspešnem klavirskem tekmovalju bodo tokrat stopile v ospredje zasedbe trobilnih kvartetov in kvintetov. Težišče repertoarja, s katerim se bodo preizkusili glasbenice in glasbeniki, je na stvaritvah glasbenega modernizma, postmodernizma ter delih sodobnih skladateljskih poetik; v ta namen je Festival Ljubljana naročil novo delo pri **Nini Šenk**, eni izmed najbolj vidnih slovenskih skladateljic. Slednja bo tudi ena izmed članov žirije, ki ji bo predsedoval umetniški vodja tekmovalja, pozavnist **Branimir Slokar**; mednarodno žirijo bodo dopolnili še trobentač **Reinhold Friedrich** in tubist **Andreas Martin Hofmeir** iz Nemčije ter hrvaški hornist **Radovan Vlatković**. V dveh finalnih večerih druge etape bo mogoče slišati predvidoma šest zasedb, ki se bodo najbolje odrezale v prvem delu tekmovalja. Najboljše zasedbe se potegujejo za denarne nagrade do 20.000 €, žirija pa bo podelila tudi priznanja za najvišje uvrščeno slovensko zasedbo ter najboljšo izvedbo dela Nine Šenk.

*The 8<sup>th</sup> Winter Festival will this year be accompanied by the **Ljubljana Festival International Competition**, open to young musicians and ensembles from all over the world. Following last year's extremely successful piano competition, it is now the turn of brass quartets and quintets. The focus of the repertoire to be performed at the competition is on modernist, postmodernist and contemporary works. To this end, the Ljubljana Festival has commissioned a new work from **Nina Šenk**, one of the most prominent young Slovene composers. She will also form a part of the judging panel, which will be chaired by **Branimir Slokar**, the competition's artistic director. The international panel will also include trumpeter **Reinhold Friedrich**, tuba player **Andreas Martin Hofmeir** (both from Germany) and the Croatian hornist **Radovan Vlatković**. The two final evenings of Round 2 of the competition are expected to include the six ensembles that acquit themselves best in the first part of the competition. The best ensembles will compete for prize money of up to 20.000 € and the judging panel will also give awards for the best-placed Slovene ensemble and the best performance of the piece written by Nina Šenk.*

**Mojca Zlobko Vajgl** je nedvomno najbolj prepoznavna in mednarodno uveljavljena slovenska solistka na harfi. S svojim dolgoletnim vrhunskim delovanjem je med drugim spodbudila nastanek številnih novih del domačih skladateljev, obenem pa na ljubljanski Akademiji za glasbo kot redna profesorica poučuje nove generacije harfistk in harfistov. Posebno pozornost namenja komorni igri, v duetu pa je večkrat nastopila tudi s sijajno francosko harfistko mlajše generacije **Marion Ravot**. Ta je v svoji dosedanji kratki karieri že sodelovala z najbolj priznanimi glasbenimi sestavi v svetovnem merilu, denimo z Berlinskim filharmoniki, Gewandhaus orkestrom iz Leipziga in Newyorško filharmonijo.

Za 8. Zimski festival sta harfistki pripravili sprehod skozi glasbeno zgodovino. Jedro programa sestavljajo dela francoske glasbene romantične in impresionistične dobe, ki sta harfo povzdignili med najbolj prefinjena in barvita glasbila. Koncertni spored dopolnjujejo baročni plesni stavki, ki bodo na harfi zasijali v povsem novi luči. Za povrh je vsestranski slovenski skladatelj **Aldo Kumar** posebej za to priložnost ustvaril novo delo, ki bo prvič zaživelo prav na ta večer.

**Mojca Zlobko Vajgl** is without question Slovenia's best known and internationally most acclaimed harpist. Over the course of her long career at the highest level, she has inspired the creation of numerous new works by Slovene composers, while at the same time teaching new generations of harpists at the Ljubljana Academy of Music, where she is a full professor. She devotes particular attention to chamber music and has frequently performed in a duo with the brilliant French harpist **Marion Ravot**. The latter's relatively brief career to date has seen her work with some of the world's most renowned orchestras, including the Berlin Philharmonic, the Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra and the New York Philharmonic.

For the 8<sup>th</sup> Winter Festival, the two harpists have prepared a journey through musical history. The core of the programme consists of French works from the Romantic and Impressionist periods, which saw the harp elevated to the ranks of the most refined and colourful instruments. The programme also includes baroque dances, which will take on a new light when performed on the harp. Finally, the versatile Slovene composer **Aldo Kumar** has created a new work especially for this occasion, which we will hear for the very first time at this concert.

**Marko Hatlak** se na svoji bogati umetniški poti že vrsto let posveča prenosu mojstrovin Johanna Sebastiana Bacha v zvočni svet harmonike. Za Zimski festival je skupaj z mojstrico različnih glasbenih slogov, mednarodno uveljavljeno sopranistko **Niko Gorič**, vsestranskima **Bernardo Fink** in **Marcosom Finkom**, ki slovenski glasbeni prostor že vrsto let bogatita s premišljenimi izvedbami tako baročne kot tudi romantične glasbe, ter tenorjem mlajše generacije **Domnom Vurnikom** pripravil edinstven večer, posvečen priredbam Bachovih vokalnih del. V redko slišani zvočni kombinaciji flavte, klavirja, violine in kontrabasa


bodo nastopili **Eva-Nina Kozmus**, zmagovalka tekmovanja Evrovizijski mladi glasbenik leta 2010, Aleksandra Pavlovič, izkušena pianistka ter cenjena komorna glasbenica in pedagoginja, nagrajena violinistka **Jelena Pejić**, ki je pravkar končala študij na ljubljanski Akademiji za glasbo in že sodeluje s številnimi uglednimi sestavi v širši regiji, ter **Stevan Jovanović**, začasni vodja sekcije kontrabasistov v Orkestru Slovenske filharmonije, ki je bil leta 2023 razglašen za najboljšega mladega umetnika Srbije. Da bo doživetje Bachovih pretanjениh večglasij resnično popolno, se bo izvajalcem pridružil tudi tridesetčlanski **Mešani pevski zbor Glasbene matice Ljubljana** pod vodstvom izkušene **Jerice Bukovec**.

Koncertni spored namenja posebno pozornost skrbno zasnovani dramaturgiji dogodka. V izvedbi Marka Hatlaka bomo sprva slišali luteranski koral, ki ga je Bach nemalokrat uporabil v različnih delih. Sledile bodo izbrane točke iz baročne mojstrovine *Pasijon po Mateju*, osrednje mesto pa bo zasedel Bachov Koncert za dva klavirja v C-duru, ki ga je skladatelj v izvirniku namenil dvema instrumentoma s tipkami, a bo tokrat zazvenel v zlitju koncertnega klavirja s harmoniko. Po vrnitvi k dramatični pripovedi o Kristusovem križanju, bodo dramaturški lok zaokrožili izseki iz dveh kantat. Koncert se bo zaključil tako, kot se je začel: z intimno začetno arijo iz *Goldbergovih variacij* na solistični harmoniki. Zares celostno zamišljen večer, poln Bachove brezčasne glasbe, ki že stoletja navdihuje skladatelje, glasbenike in poslušalce.

**Marko Hatlak's** rich artistic career has for a number of years included a mission to transfer the masterpieces of Johann Sebastian Bach into the sound world of the accordion. Together with the internationally acclaimed soprano **Nika Gorič**, who excels in a range of musical styles, the versatile **Bernarda** and **Marcos Fink**, who have been enriching Slovenia's musical landscape for years with their well-considered performances of works from the baroque and romantic repertoires, and the young tenor **Domen Vurnik**, he has prepared, for this year's Winter Festival, a unique evening dedicated to Bach's vocal works. Appearing in the rarely heard combination of flute, piano, violin and double bass will be **Eva-Nina Kozmus**, winner of the Eurovision Young Musician title in 2010, **Aleksandra Pavlovič**, an experienced pianist and respected chamber musician and teacher, **Jelena Pejić**, an award-winning violinist who has recently graduated from the Ljubljana Academy of Music and who collaborates with numerous prestigious ensembles across the wider region, and **Stevan Jovanović**, a permanent mem-

ber of the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra and temporary leader of the double bass section, who in 2023 was proclaimed the best young artist in Serbia. To make the experience of Bach's intricate polyphonies truly complete, the performers will be joined by the 30-member **Choir of the Glasbena Matica Ljubljana** under experienced choir director **Jerica Butkovec**.

The concert programme devotes particular attention to the carefully designed dramaturgy of the event. To start with, we will hear Marko Hatlak's performance of a Lutheran chorale used by Bach in several works. This will be followed by excerpts from the St Matthew Passion, one of the masterpieces of baroque sacred music. The centrepiece of the concert will be Bach's Concerto for two harpsichords in C major, originally composed for two keyboard instruments but performed here by concert grand piano and accordion. Following a return to the dramatic narrative of the Crucifixion, the dramaturgical arc will conclude with excerpts from two cantatas. The concert will end as it began: with a solo accordion performance of the intimate opening aria of the Goldberg Variations. A complete and carefully planned evening full of Bach's timeless music that has been inspiring composers, musicians and listeners for centuries.

**Zagrebški solisti** so godalni komorni ansambel z eno najdaljših tradicij v regiji. Predlani je sestav praznoval 70 let nepretrganega delovanja, odkar so ga leta 1953 ustanovili v okviru Radia Zagreb. V tem času so izvedli več kot 4000 koncertov na vseh celinah ter posneli več kot sedemdeset zgoščenk. Osvojili so vse najpomembnejše državne nagrade in prejeli številna mednarodna priznanja. Igrati v Zagrebških solistih velja za eno najvišjih časti, ki lahko doleti hrvaškega glasbenika, njihovi koncerti pa slovijo kot sinonim za kar najbolj vrhunske izvedbe.

Program bosta uvedli dve mladostni deli: *Sinfonija za godala v h-molu* Felixa Mendelsshona Bartholdyja je izkaz kompozicijske odličnosti štirinajstletnega čudežnega dečka, *Preprosta simfonija* Benjamina Brittna pa je nastala na podlagi drobnih zamisli, ki jih je skladatelj skiciral kot otrok, pri svojih dvajsetih pa jih je oblikoval v igrivo skladbo za godala. Spored bo mladostniški elan soočil z dvema polnokrvnima mojstrovinama. *Adagietto* Gustava Mahlerja, četrти stavek iz znamenite *Sinfonije št. 5*, je ljubezensko posvetilo njegovi ženi Almi in velja za enega najbolj prepoznavnih odlomkov glasbe minulega stoletja, na koncertnih odrih pa pogosto živi kar kot samostojna skladba. Lahkotna *Serenada za godala v C-duru* Petra Ilijča Čajkovskega, prezeta z značilno spevnimi melodijami, pa je preizkusni kamen slehernega godalnega sestava in dolgoletna stalnica na sporedih Zagrebških solistov.

The **Zagreb Soloists** are one of the longest-established string chamber ensembles in central Europe. Formed as a performing ensemble of Radio Zagreb in 1953, they celebrated 70 years of uninterrupted activity last year. In that time they have given more than 4,000 concerts all over the world and recorded more than 70 albums. They have won all the most important national prizes and numerous international accolades. To play with the Zagreb Soloists is one of the greatest honours that can befall a Croatian musician and the ensemble's concerts have become byword for performances of the very highest calibre.

The programme will open with two youthful works: Symphony for Strings in B minor by Felix Mendelsson Bartholdy is a display of the compositional mastery of the fourteen-year-old prodigy, while Simple Symphony by Benjamin Britten is based on fragmentary ideas the composer sketched out as a child and then developed into a playful composition for strings at the age of 20. Contrasting with this youthful elan, the programme will continue with two thoroughgoing masterpieces.

*Adagietto by Gustav Mahler, the fourth movement of his celebrated Fifth Symphony, is a kind of love note dedicated to the composer's wife Alma. One of the most recognisable pieces of music of the last century, it is frequently performed in concert as a stand-alone work. Light-hearted Serenade for Strings in C major by Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky, with its characteristically lilting melodies, is something of a touchstone for every string ensemble and has long been a constant of the concert programmes of the Zagreb Soloists.*

# GRIGORJ SOKOLOV

Štiriinsedemdesetletni ruski pianist **Grigorij Sokolov** spada v sam vrh panteona mojstrov črno-belih tipk, številni kritiki pa ga že dolgo razglašajo za najboljšega pianista na svetu. Čeprav je na svoj izjemni dar opozoril že pri dvanajstih letih, pri šestnajstih pa kot najmlajši v zgodovini osvojil prestižno Mednarodno tekmovanje Čajkovskega, so ga tedanje politične razmere omejevale na nastope v domovini. Veliki preboj na mednarodne odre je doživel šele v poznih osemdesetih letih in bliskovito postal eden najbolj iskanih glasbenikov. Koncertiral je z vsemi najuglednejšimi svetovnimi orkestri, a je po nekaj letih ugotovil, da svojo glasbeno vizijo najlažje izrazi s pianističnimi recitali. Odtlej

nastopi približno sedemdesetkrat letno, saj si za vsak koncertni spored vzame čas, da ga premišljeno sestavi in se vanj popolnoma poglobi, preden ga predstavi občinstvu. Kritiki ob vseh njegovih presežkih najpogosteje izpostavljajo izjemno zvočno barvno paletto, ki jo Sokolov izvabi iz klavirja. Da doseže popolno zvočno doživetje, ima zelo visoke zahteve od koncertnega klavirja, ki ga pričaka na odru. Ure in ure presedi s klavirskimi tehnikami, preučuje tehnične značilnosti inštrumenta ter ga prilagaja svojim strogim standardom. Kot pravi sam: »Vsak klavir ima svojo osebnost in z njo se je treba seznaniti, saj igrava skupaj!«


The 74-year-old Russian pianist **Grigory Sokolov** occupies one of the highest places in the pantheon of piano masters, with several critics over the years having proclaimed him the world's greatest living pianist. His remarkable talent began attracting attention when he was just 12 and at 16 he became the youngest ever winner of the prestigious International Tchaikovsky Piano Competition. Owing to the political situation at the time, however, he was limited to performances in his homeland. His international breakthrough did not come until the late 1980s, after which he rapidly became one of the world's most sought-after musicians, performing with all the world's most prestigious orchestras. After a few years, however, he realised that the easiest way for him to express his musical vision was through piano recitals.

Since then he has given no more than around 70 performances a year, taking the time to prepare every recital programme with care and immersing himself in it fully before presenting it to an audience. Of all his superlative qualities, the one most frequently noted by critics is the remarkable tonal palette that Sokolov coaxes from the piano. In order to ensure the perfect aural experience and sonic quality, he makes very high demands of the instrument that awaits him on the concert stage. He spends long hours with piano technicians examining the technical characteristics of the instrument and adapting it to his own strict standards. As he himself says: »You need hours to understand the piano because each piano has its own personality, and we play together!«

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
